

Introduction to ScreenRuler

Thank you for choosing ScreenRuler. ScreenRuler is a PC software product to allow part of the PC screen to be highlighted. This will assist you with viewing and concentrating on text. It provides a "strip" across the screen, which can be magnified, can have the contrast changed and have the background darkened out if desired.



ScreenRuler will work with any piece of software, as it acts as an "overlay" on the PC screen. From a technical point of view, it should not interfere or clash with your PC video card.

ScreenRuler Operation

Once you have launched ScreenRuler from the Start Menu, it will stay as an open application and will work with all other software. When you are working in a software application, for example Microsoft Word, the ScreenRuler Menu Bar will minimise itself automatically so it is out of your way.



If you would like to change one of the ScreenRuler Control settings, click on the ScreenRuler minimised window and it will appear in front of the other software. Alternatively, pressing Alt Key and Tab key simultaneously will allow you to switch to the ScreenRuler.



ScreenRuler Main Controls



Magnify Button



This allows the ScreenRuler strip to be magnified by a factor of two. Therefore, all text and images will be magnified by the ScreenRuler strip. To remove magnification, bring up the ScreenRuler control bar, and click on the magnifying glass.

Contrast Button



If the Magnify Button is enabled, magnifying the text and graphics inside the ScreenRuler strip, then clicking the Contrast Button will contrast or invert the colors inside the strip. For certain users, this may be easier to read text. For example, black text on a white background will appear as white text on a black background when inverted.

Mouse Button



This changes the colour style of the mouse cursor.

Help Button



Opens the Help File

ScreenRuler "Strip" Controls





 turns off the ScreenRuler horizontal strip, and leaves you with a plain single line to assist you with reading and concentrating.

 darkens the area above the ScreenRuler strip

 darkens the area below the ScreenRuler strip

 When magnification is on, this button darkens the screen above and below the ScreenRuler strip. This button has no effect if the magnification feature is off.

 These buttons vary the darkness setting for the dark section of the screen, if selected. It can be changed from light, through grey, to black.

 The Up/Down arrows change the width of the ScreenRuler Strip.
